Welcome to our very special area on beautiful Lake Tahoe. If you plan on using our park & beach facilities, we wanted to share with you some important rules and regulations of the property that should be helpful for you.

1. Hours of operation: 24/7 with the staff on duty 8:00am to about 10:00pm. During non staffed hours we need you to be especially aware of your trash and take it with you so as not to feed the bears and raccoons.
2. Picnic table reservations are limited to one table and can only be made within 30 days of your date needed.
3. Entry to the park must be with your key card at the entrance gate ONLY! Remember lost key cards cost \$50.00 each to replace. Only members, renters, and their guests in possession of a key card are allowed in the park.
4. Piers are for boats first, sunbathing second, swimming third, and fishing fourth. Fishing is permitted only in the early morning or in the evening when people are not using the piers for sunbathing, and/or swimming or boating.
5. Coolers and chairs are not allowed on the piers. An aisle must be kept clear on the piers for normal traffic.
6. This is a family oriented park. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by the park staff will result in your having to leave the property.
7. Loud music is not permitted after 8:00 PM.
8. Use of the Canoe and kayak storage area is by reservation and application only. (See on site Manager for details).
9. Piers are for loading and unloading only with a 10 minute limit.
10. The buoys are available for member's boats only.
11. Only charcoal can be used in BBQ's.
12. Volleyball, basketball, and horseshoe pits are on a first come first served basis.
13. When the park is open for the season and the card lock system is operational then there will be NO DOGS ALLOWED in the park, on the beach, or on the piers.
14. No rock throwing is allowed in the park.
15. Parents not monitoring their children will be directed to leave the park.

Thank you for helping us to keep our park and beach a fun, safe and enjoyable place to be. It is for the enjoyment of all our members and their guests.
